Estéban's seasonal dinner menu features Executive Chef Trejo's signature dishes including *Grilled Octopus*, Marquita farm herbs, baby carrots, red sorrel; *Cataplana*, Portuguese stew of clams, whole prawns, mussels, Pacific catch, country bread; *Pulled Pork Empanadas* with feta cheese, tomatillo sauce; *Rib-eye Steak*, herb roasted potato, harvest vegetables, Rioja wine jus and *Harvest Paella* free-range chicken, caggiano sausage. Signature spooky beverages add extra spirit to the evening and include the *Graveyard Punch*, Kahlua, cream de cocoa and orange juice and *Vampire Goblet* features strawberry vodka, Chambord, strawberry juice, cranberry juice with a blood-strawberry sugar rim.

Tasty Treats menu is served for four-legged guests. Vegans devour *Clyde's Favorite* that features roasted pumpkin, cauliflower and fresh apples. Finish with a *BarkDay Cake*, made of bacon, beef franks, burger patty, rice and sugarless whipped cream.
